#### SFCC MUSIC & RECORDING ARTS STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The SFCC Music & Recording Arts Student Scholarship is awarded to current SFCC students, full or part-time, participating in music or audio engineering at SFCC.

### Scholarship Award Process:

- Scholarships are funded annually in the fall and distributed across the three quarters of the academic year in which they are awarded.
- Award amounts and the number of scholarships depend on available funds.
- Recipients are notified prior to the end of winter quarter.
- Awards are processed in the spring by the CCS Foundation and allocated to recipients in the fall.

### Requirements Needed:

- A full-time or part-time student.
- Enrolled at SFCC and participating in the music or audio engineering programs.
- Nominated by a SFCC music or recording arts instructor.
- Enrolled in one of the following programs: MUSIC AFA, MUSIC DTA, MUSIC DTA/MRP, or AAS Audio Engineering.
- Must have a minimum 2.5 GPA in all courses.

# **Application Form Procedure:**

- Submit a completed scholarship application form (page 2).
- Submit a letter of intent describing how you meet the qualifications.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from your private music or audio instructor.
- Submit unofficial transcripts of college level courses to date.
- Students will be notified by email if they are selected to move forward as finalists.
  - Music finalists will complete a <u>live audition</u> during the second or third week of March,
    presenting two contrasting stylistic pieces and demonstrating appropriate technique.
  - Audio engineering finalists should contact the Audio Program Lead for details on preparing their finalist submission.
